HOW TO APPLY

Selected applicants will receive details for a video interview to answer a few brief questions. All applicants will be notified by the end of December.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

We are looking for ambitious and focused sophomore students interested in growing and working with great teams to help our clients achieve personal and financial success.

Eligibility criteria for ideal candidates:

- ► Be enrolled in an accredited university with a graduation date between December 2027 - June 2028
- ► Major in accounting, computer science, data science, economics, finance, information systems, marketing, management, math, sales, statistics, or any other business-related field
- ► Have a minimum of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (Minimum 3.5 GPA for IB Insights Bootcamp.)
- ► Be passionate about a career in financial services and working with diverse teams and customers

The application deadline for IB Insights is **October 9, 2025**. All other sophomore program applications are due by **November 2, 2025**.
